



Application Process

Stage 1: The application consists of:

- CV (max 2 pages long)
- Personal Statement (information of what to include can be found below)

Your application will be assessed by students who currently study a subject similar to yours at one of the best universities in the United Kingdom.

Stage 2: We will conduct interviews in Krakow with 20 shortlisted candidates.

The 11 winners will be announced during the Wine Reception on the interview day.

Personal Statement Guide:

1000 words' length in English

Please use Harvard referencing style

Please insert your name and email in the header

What to include:

- **Why you are applying** – this may be linked to your career goals, academic interests, personal development plans.
- **Your academic and non-academic experience** – highlight relevant skills and knowledge that will enable you to make an impact. This may include grades, awards, placements or conferences attended.
- **Your preparation** – address how undergraduate study has prepared you for further professional development.
- **Interest in the field** – area you want to specialise in, papers that you find interesting and how you might contribute to this particular field.
- **Your skillset** – mention the abilities that you've developed throughout your undergraduate studies.
- **Your goals** – consider your short-term educational aims and long-term career ambitions, and how studying at this particular university will help you in accomplishing these goals.
